



Location and Community

With its rugged beauty and unique location on the edge of North America, Newfoundland and Labrador is a place that inspires passion, ingenuity, and innovation.

The Innovation Centre is located in St. John's, NL, a location that was chosen for its ease of access to the St. John's International Airport, proximity to provincial highways, co-location to various key Industries, businesses and ecosystem partners. It is poised to be a demonstration destination, highlighting what the province has to offer.

Where does an economy find its spark? Here, it's in the unique combination of people, place, and purpose. Today, with a growing economy and boundless opportunity, we are poised to make a technological leap forward, together. Building

This building comprises a total of 54,143 sq ft internal area arranged over an expansive first floor and newly built mezzanine space.

A renovated, 54,143 sq ft building situated centrally within a growing innovation district.

Main floor office premises account for approximately 20,699 sq ft, which will include a variety of working, collaboration, and meeting spaces (e.g. single desk offices, multi-desk offices, open-desks, co-working spaces, soundproof-meeting spaces, etc).

An additional 10,270 sq ft of office space will be available on the mezzanine level, with a similar mix of working, collaboration and meeting spaces.

Incorporates a 1,356 sq ft lounge offering food and beverages on the main floor, as part of the atrium reception and close by outdoor seating areas.

Offers total 21,818 sq ft of Light industrial and custom maker spaces in separate main floor area.

On-site parking and external lay-down space is also available.
