We recognize the significant contributions the sector has already made, from generating \$1.8 billion in GDP to employing nearly 10,000 people, and we are encouraged by the bold vision of reaching \$2.5 billion by 2030. Your brief highlights the critical opportunities for continued growth and underscores the importance of partnership between government, industry, and communities.

We envision a strong, innovation-driven economy. By working with industry groups, businesses, and innovators, we can make this province a top choice for investment and job creation. We will support a culture of collaboration and help local tech start-ups grow into larger companies that attract international attention.

To encourage the technology industry to prosper, a Wakeham PC government will:

- Work with industry to promote tech-driven solutions to challenges in traditional industries. We will host networking sessions so innovators can showcase their technologies across the economy and collaborate with other sectors to solve problems.
- Establish a new process for the procurement of innovation by government and
 government-funded entities, ensuring terms and conditions do not prevent local
 companies from accessing capital investment. Procuring innovation is not the same as
 procuring goods. We will take a *local-first* approach to ensure that local innovators have
 an advantage.
- Expand the technology talent pool by training more computer scientists and providing
 upskilling opportunities for unemployed and underemployed individuals seeking new
 careers in the tech industry.
- Create an Intellectual Property Office to assist local businesses and innovators in protecting their intangible assets.



- Re-establish Newfoundland and Labrador as a world leader in ocean technology by restarting our ocean strategy, supporting research, and building on our strengths in fisheries, marine science, offshore energy, and Arctic exploration.
- Expand opportunities for students to learn new technologies in our K-12 school system.

Following the election, we remain committed to engaging with techNL and the broader technology community. Your insights will help shape the dialogue on how Newfoundland and Labrador can build a stronger, more diversified economy, while positioning the province as a leader in the global tech ecosystem.

We thank you again for your leadership and for bringing forward the voices of your members. We look forward to continuing this important conversation.
